OBJECTIVE

The exam consists of 110 single correct answer MCQs.

The aim is to assess whether the candidate meets the minimum level of knowledge required by the EBU.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates meet one of the following criteria:

- Final-year resident: Trained as part of an official national urology training programme. Training must be completed no later than October 2027.
- Certified urologist: Holds a national urology specialist diploma issued in an EBU member country.

ASSESSMENTQ

This is a web-based exam taken via the platform assessmentQ.

For security reasons the exam is fully supervised by an online invigilator.

SCORING

We apply cohort-based standard setting. For the cut-off score we look at the average score and standard deviation. There is no negative marking. The content is not disclosed.
